 and as touching these worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to Bless
 me in this Life I Give devise and Dispose of in the following Manner and
 form. (and first) Let all my Debts be paid Secondly I Give and bequeath
 to my Son Archibald Woods ten pounds Thirdly I Give and bequeath
 to Son John Woods Ten pounds. Fourthly I Give and bequeath to Daughter
Jarah Ten pounds Fifthly I Give and Bequeath to Daughter Mannah
 Ten pounds Sixthly I Give and Bequeath My Deceased Daughter
Margaret's Children Ten pounds.
 Seventhly I Give and Bequeath to Son Archibald and Son John my
 six hundred and eighty acres of Land Lying on Joy Creek and that
 the said Land shall be sold and the Money Divided among ^{the} Son
John and William Wallace Families and that each Grand
 child now in being shall have an Equall share.
 Eighthly I Give and bequeath to Son William Woods Twenty Shilling
 which shall be paid out of said Land.
 Ninthly I Give to Williams Son Michael Twenty Shillings which
 shall be paid out said Land.
 Tenthly I Give and bequeath to Daughter Jarah one Pistole which
 shall be of the Ready money now By me.
 Eleventhly I Give and Bequeath to Son Archibald's Son Michael
 one Pistole

and I do hereby utterly revoke and Dissolve all and every other
 former Testaments Wills Legacies Bequests and Executors by me
 in any way before named Wills and Bequests, Ratifying and
 confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the Day and
